- ➤ Playground information: 2015: \$86,000
  - Now this would be \$162,000 for equipment and \$72,000 for installation
  - May not have enough space for playground, petition city?

- Trustee Report / Q 'n A (Todd Brandt):
  - Follow Highlights Link to find details on their meetings from Rocky View Schools site
  - > Change needed to offset capacity at schools, options include :
    - 1. Create a new High School for Airdrie
    - 2. Adjust grade levels within schools
    - 3. Reshuffle of grade configurations and attendance boundaries within Airdrie - some areas will have a lot more change than others based on population etc.
    - New School in planning stage in South Windsong (K-8),
    - Pre-Planning for New High School in South Windsong, beside New Rec Centre: RVS has approved, but waiting on construction funding so could be 3 or more years until breaking ground
  - > BALANCING AIRDRIE STUDENT SPACES public engagement
    - Details will be available in a few days after the next meeting for a communication to discuss all points with the public
  - > Q: Why are new developments going in without schools for these kids?
    - A: each development must provide land and services for a school, however, this does not account for government approval and funds
