School Lunch Program  
Behaviour & Expectation Acknowledgement Form  
2016/2017**



Student participation in the Herons Crossing School Lunch Program involves the following expectations:

- All lunch students must have a completed lunch program registration form on file at the school
- All drop in students must have a parent written signed note and \$1.00 drop in payment sent in the student agenda on or before the day the student is to stay for lunch
- All lunch food items will be sent from home on a daily basis; the only exception will occur on special days when the school holds a fun lunch program (ample prior notice will be provided to all families)
- As our school is a **100% NUT FREE school**, no student is allowed to bring any food to school containing any nut products; those bringing these products will immediately be sent to the school office to finish their lunch and will receive a reminder notice in the front pocket in their student agenda; repeated episodes may result in student removal in the lunch program
- **All beverages must be sent in reusable, spill-proof containers as any disposable containers will be returned home unopened; we prefer that students have water as their lunch time drink**
- Please discuss food options for Fridays with your children; many students are sent with only a snack but ask supervisors for additional food to supplement their own
- All students participating in the school lunch program but going home for lunch on an emergent basis MUST have a parent-written note in their agenda AND must sign out at the office

**Behaviour Expectations:**

- All students will remain seated at all time in their lunchroom, raising their hands if they need support or to use the washroom
- No sharing of food is allowed in the lunch program
- Students must return all uneaten food to their lunch kits, save fruit cores or peels, to allow parents to know what has been eaten; we do not allow students to throw away uneaten or partially eaten foods
- All students agree to listen to, and follow, any lunch supervisor requests the first time they are given
- Students are responsible to have proper eating manners and clean up any mess they have made in the lunchroom
- Lunch kits and water bottles are expected to be returned home daily
- When transitioning to lunch recess, students will independently and quickly put on proper attire to suit the weather
- Students will walk safely and in single file in the halls, holding on to hand railings when traveling on steps
- Students will keep their bodies to themselves and will only use kind words throughout the lunch hour
- No student will leave the play boundaries at any time during the recess period; if any child needs to go to the office or washroom, he/she will obtain permission from the lunch supervisor

**I have read and agree to follow the expectations for participation in the Herons Crossing School Lunch Program and understand that if I do not follow these expectations, I could be suspended or removed from the Herons Crossing School Lunch Program.**
